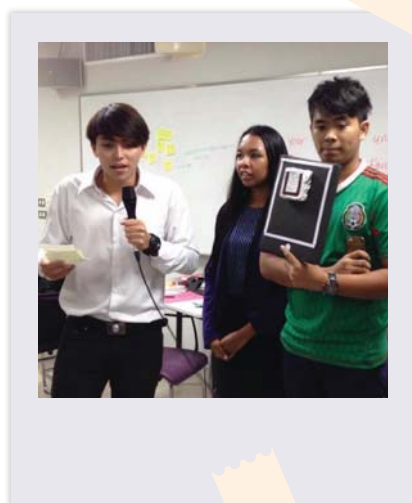

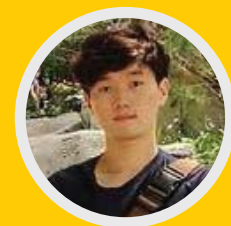

UTCC International students are offered to have access to a wealth of opportunities to develop their professional and business networks. 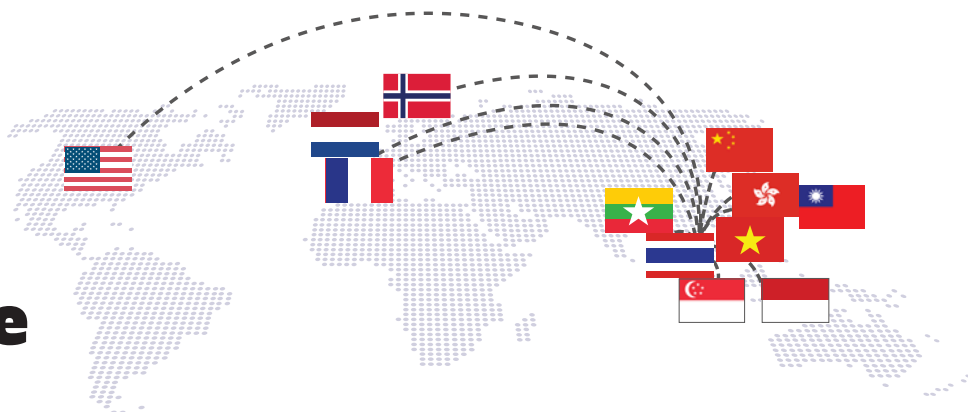

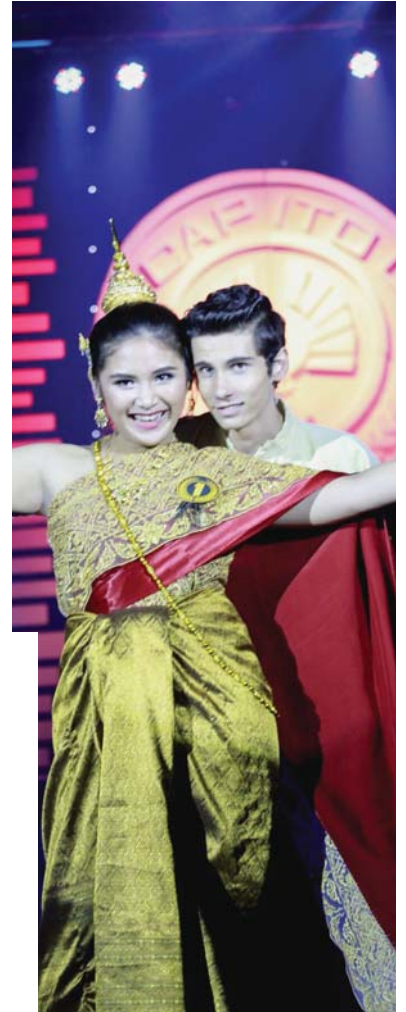




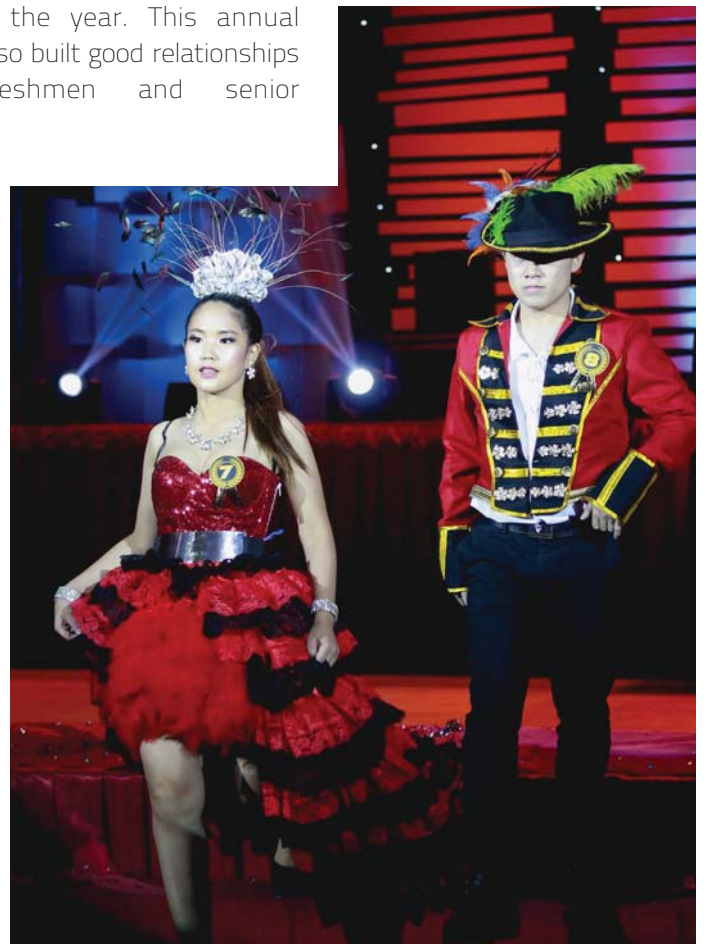
Freshmen and current students get together for annual **Freshman Night** at **UTCC Auditorium**
