
UTCC Songkran Festival




ASEAN YOUTH WORKSHOP ON MEDIA LITERACY BANGKOK, THAILAND

Inspirations




Expanding Collaboration in Lao PDR

What has UTCC International done that has helped you obtain or better prepare yourself for your internship?




What advice would you give to someone in your field?



How to apply:

1/ Oualifications:

Applicants must complete Mathayom 6 or its equivalent levels from high school (grade 12 from American-system schools or O-Level from British- system schools) or Completion of GED with the score over 410.

2/ Document Requirements:

A/ Mathayom 6 transcript and certificate or its equivalent levels from high school (grade 12 from American-system schools or O-Level from British- system schools) or Completion of GED with the score over 410.

B/Copy of Identity card (for Thai nationality) or passport (for Non-Thai nationality)

3/ Admission Requirements:

A/ Applicants are required to hold a "Pass Level" Math and English Entrance Test.

B/ Pass the Personal Interview by Program committee.

C/ Applicants may be admitted on condition that they take preparation courses in English and Math (depending on Entrance Test results).
