

Independence Day Celebration Invitation from the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia



On 20 August 2019, the University of the Thai Chamber of Commerce (UTCC) was honored to attend the reception of the Indonesian Independence day celebration at the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia, Bangkok, Thailand. The event was held in the Chadra Ballroom, Siam Kempinski Hotel. Several distinguished invitees attended the event including diplomats of various countries.

In this reception event, UTCC was represented by 3 Indonesian students with 1 UTCC staff from the International School of Management (UTCC iSM). At the end of the event, our representative managed to take a photo with His Excellency Mr. Ahmad Rusdi, the current Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia for the Kingdom of Thailand. As written in history, Indonesia proclaimed their independency from Netherlands and Japan colonialism on 17 August 1945. Mr. Ir. Soekarno was the man who read the proclamation text accompanied by Mr. Mohammad Hatta, who later became his Vice President and several Indonesian national figures.

After the independence, Indonesia was one of several nations who vocally promote the Non-Block Movement as a neutral political movement alongside with Yugoslavia (now Bosnia-Herzegovina, Croatia, Macedonia, Kosovo, Montenegro, Serbia, and Slovenia). Furthermore, Indonesia also one of the founding members of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations or widely known as ASEAN.

This event was a good opportunity for strengthening the relationship between the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia and UTCC International School of Management.



Smile-to-pay: A big leap through new technology in terms of making payments in China

Nowadays, people get used to paying by scanning QR code or barcode. this system was first invented in Japan to keep track of ingredients. Through years, it has been using widely, especially in China in mobile payments. However, from now on, QR code and barcode could soon be the things in the past, and replaced by the facial recognition system in payments.

Alipay first showed its Dragonfly facial recognition system – an upgrade of



Smile-to-pay system last year (in December). Since then, they expanded it to over 300 provinces in China. Tencent, a company which created WeChat app with over 600 million customers, revealed its new facial payment machine called "Frog Pro" in August, when a growing number of start-ups are trying to embark on the thriving industry.

Shinsegae, a South Korean department store franchise, also rolled out Wechat Pay facial recognition payment on 29 October. Thanks to it, the facial recognition system was first used outside China. Boasting 99% accuracy, the system completes payments within ten seconds.

Normally, it's very dangerous to enter the password if someone's beside you. Using this system can be a not only a convenient way to pay for the stuffs but also a great way to enhance the privacy of the customers.


